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**SUBJECT** : **COMPULSORY REGISTRATION ON NHIMA SCHEME**

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The University received correspondence from National Health Insurance and Medical Authority (NHIMA) requiring all students to be registered under its scheme in accordance with the National Health Insurance Scheme Act No. 2 of 2018 and the Statutory Instrument No. 63 of 2019. This matter was deliberated with you and it was resolved that we:

- i. Discontinue the inhouse student medical schemes with all institutions effective 1st February 2026;
- ii. Discontinue charging students K100.00 per semester as contribution towards the existing scheme; and
- iii. Register students with NHIMA and make them contribute directly to NHIMA a K30.00 per student per month effective. The modalities of payments through mobile money shall be shared shortly

Given the above, Mulungushi University implores all students to have a valid NHIMA card at all times to avoid any inconvenience in the event that you require medical service.

In order to ensure compliance, course registration and approval can only be done upon production of a valid NHIMA subscription in addition to having paid the 50% of the tuition fees.
